## **Tournament Rules**

The Titan invitational is hosted by the Papillion Titans Bowling Club, The Bowling Store, Mockingbird Lanes & Bowling Artworks. Competition is open to all high school bowling teams of good academic standing and currently attending Junior High or High School. Teams are composed of students attending their particular school unless approved by tournament director in advance.

In case of bad weather or a player does not show. A team may borrow another team's player with the approval of the tournament director. Each participant may enter only once.

This is a USBC sanctioned tournament; all participants must be sanctioned through USBC. Participation fee of \$2.00 must be paid if not a USBC member. This is a scratch tournament with JV and Varsity divisions.

Playing strength for each boys team is 5 bowlers with a roster of 6 allowed. No substitutions during a game will be allowed without good cause and approval of the tournament director. Substitutions between games are allowed.

Playing strength for each girls team is 4 bowlers with a roster of 5 allowed.

Tournament format is 3 regular games, then 3 baker games.

Boys cut to the top 8 teams, girls cut to the top 4.

Finals will consist of 2 baker games with total pin fall moving on.

All persons bowling or attending the tournament are expected to behave in a positive and appropriate manner. Any person(s) not displaying appropriate mannerisms will be removed from the tournament.

Players, 2 coaches and tournament officials only will be allowed in the bowling area.

All rules not covered here will be according to USBC guidelines, and the tournament director's decision is final for all disputes.
