#### **Tournament Rules:**

- 1. The North Bend Invitational Tournament is sponsored by the North Bend Bowling Club and is open to all bowling teams of High School students in good academic standing and attending high school. (Public or private) Teams are composed of students attending one particular school unless approved by the tournament director prior to the tournament. In case of bad weather or a player not showing up, a team may borrow another team's player only by the approval of the tournament director.
- 2. Entry fee is \$75.00 for Boys & \$65.00 for girls per team. <u>PLEASE PAY IN ADVANCE</u>. Prize fund returned 100% in awards. Award medals are given for 1st & 2nd in championship flight and the consolation champion. All extra awards money will be in scholarships. Awards will be provided by the North Bend Bowling Club as follows:

Scholarships: Boys High Game, Girls High Game

**All - Tournament Team Captains** 

1st Place team - Scholarship for each Member

- 3. All bowlers must be USBC sanctioned. Participation fee will be required if no sanction card.
- 4. All competition will be scratch.
- 5. There will be separate bowling divisions for boys and girls.
- Playing strength of each team shall be five bowlers for boys and 4 for girls, although a team's roster may carry eight players. Straw scores will be set prior per NHSBCA guidelines.
- Substitutes are not allowed during a match except in the case of extreme accident or injury. Line-up may change at the beginning each game.
- 8. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Some sessions may fill up and you may be asked to bowl at a different time.
- After cut, top 8 teams cut into 2 flights. Championship & Consolation Flight 50% of pin total of the 3 games and 100% of the 3 baker game in qualifying will carry over to semi-final bakers round. Baker Semi Final Flights: 4 baker games, (3RR &1PR) across 4 lanes. 30 points for win. 15 points for tie. Top 2 teams will Advance to finals in each flight. Best 2 game total wins.
- 10. All coaches, players, and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and gestures will not be tolerated and may result in player or team removal.
- 11. Players, two coaches per team, and tournament officials are allowed in the bowling area.
- 12. Smart account #11183 will be used for Scholarships awarded.
- 13. Any rules not covered here will be settled in accordance to USBC playing rules.
- 14. Any changes announced prior to beginning of competition will take precedence.
