Tournament Rules

- 1. The Westbrook Invitational Tournament is sponsored by the Columbus Area Bowling Club and is open to all bowling teams of high school students in good academic standing and attending a High School (public or private). Teams are composed of students attending one particular school unless approved by Tournament Director prior to tournament. In case of bad weather or player not showing up, a team may borrow another team's player only by approval of Tournament Director. This is a fun time tournament.
- The Westbrook Invitational Varity High School & JV Tournament will be USBC Certified. Accordingly, all
 participants must be USBC Youth members. Any bowler not a USBC Youth member must pay a
 participation fee.
- 3. Entry Fee is \$75.00 per boys team Please pay in advance!! Bowling \$50.00 Awards \$14.00 Expenses \$6.00 and \$5.00 to the NHSCA to run the Nebraska High school Championship.

 Entry Fee is 65.00 per girls team please pay in advance!! Bowling \$44.00 awards \$12.00 Expenses \$4.00 And \$5.00 NHSCA to run the Nebraska High School Championship

 Qualifying points for the NHSBCA Championship will be awarded to the top 10 teams.
- 4. There will be separate divisions for boys and girl's varsity and junior varsity.
- 5. Playing strength of each team shall be five bowlers, boys and 4 girls although a team's roster may carry up to eight players.
- 6. All competition will be scratch
- 7. Substitutions are not allowed during a game, qualifying or baker, except in case of extreme accident or injury. Line-up may change, however for a subsequent game.
- 8. Each division will be limited to 16 teams
- 9. Tournament format: All teams will roll three games of qualifying, with 6 bakers games, then take top 3 for step ladder. Team 3 will bowl team 2 winner bowls team 1. 2 game total
- 10. All players, coaches and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and/or gestures will not be tolerated and may result in a player or teams being ejected from the tournament.
- 11. Players, two coaches per team and the tournament officials only will be allowed in the bowling area. All other spectators must remain behind the bowling area.
- 12. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. See Rule 10. Contact the Tournament Director by Saturday December 12, 2015
- 13. Awards will be provided by the Columbus Area Bowling Club as followed: Each Division:
 - 1st Place team metals.
 - 2nd Place team metals
 - High game and series awards in both boys and girls divisions.
- 14. Any rule not covered here will be settled in accordance to USBC playing rules
- 15. Any changes announced prior to beginning competition will take precedence.
- 16. USBC Rule 305 requires all award fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100 percent to the participants in that event or division of that event.
